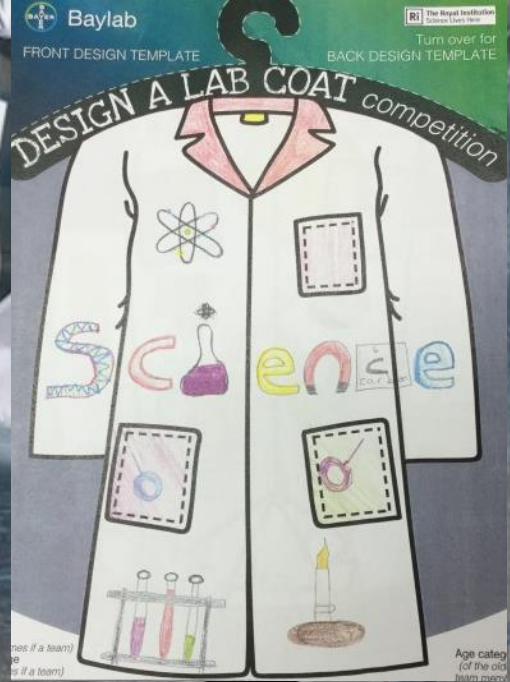
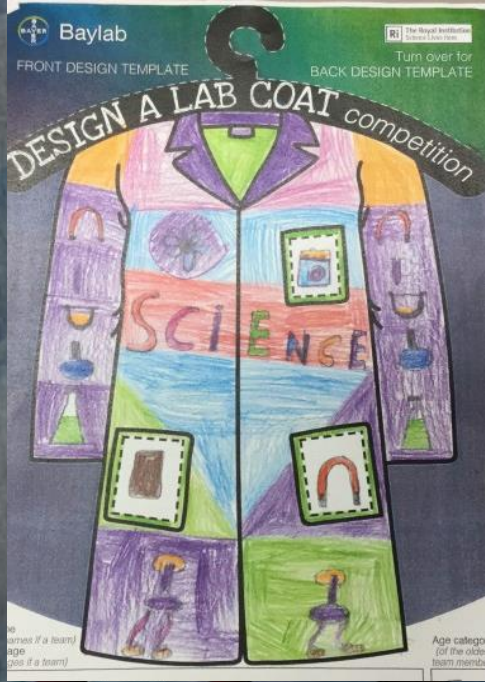
You need to design a lab coat that shows what science means to you.

You have until Monday 21<sup>st</sup> March to submit your lab coat design.

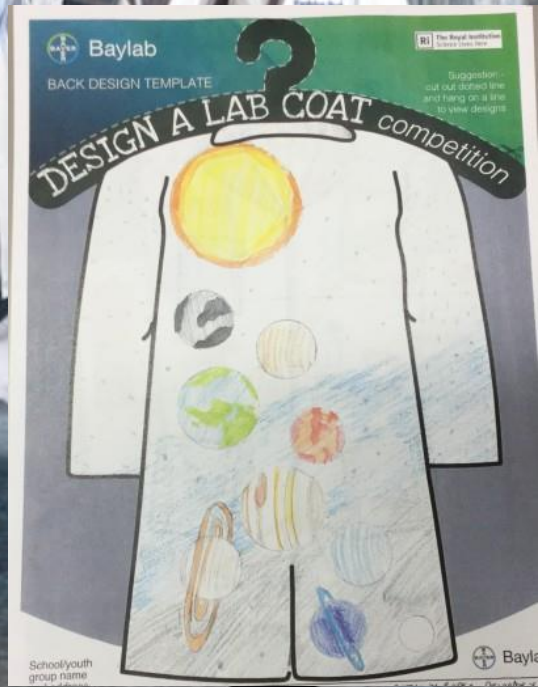
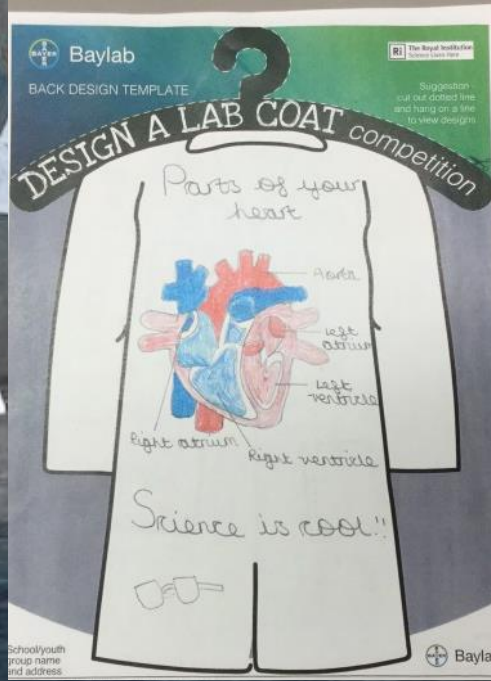
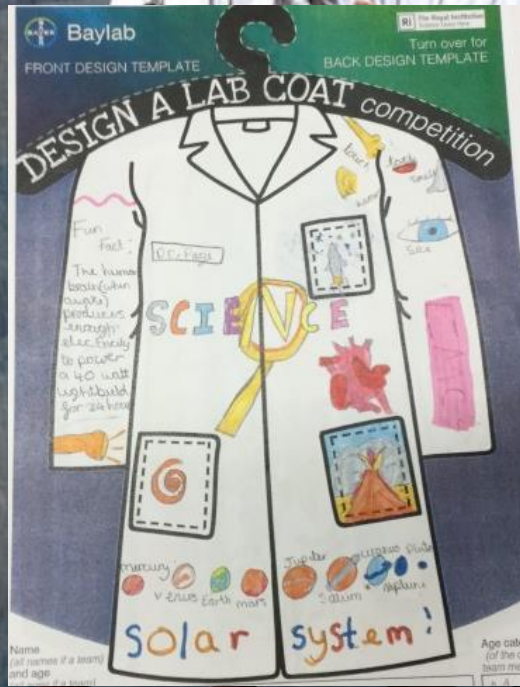


# Here are some examples of designs:
